Purpose:

The purpose of this fund is to assist Chinese language teacher candidates with costs related to tuition and/or student fees for coursework in pursuit of training, state licensure or certification to become K-12 Chinese language teachers.

Eligibility: Full-time [X] Part-time [X] Graduate [X] Undergraduate []

Recipients must be enrolled full-time or part-time in East Asian Languages & Literatures (EALL), Second Language Studies (SLS), Asian Studies (SHAPS), or College of Education (COE), be seeking both an M.A. degree and a state-level teaching certification, and have intent to teach K-12. Recipients must have U.S. Citizenship or Permanent Residency in the U.S.

Criteria:

- 1. Preference given to those with advanced Chinese language proficiency.
2. Preference given to non-native speakers of Chinese with a B.A. (or higher) in Chinese language and literature or Asian Studies.
3. Preference given to native Chinese speakers with a B.A. degree (or higher), a minimum TOEFL score of 600, and/or teaching experience in the U.S.
4. Preference given to those who are currently teaching in Hawai'i or have a job offer to teach Chinese contingent on obtaining certification.

Number and Amount of Awards:

The CollegeBoard will distribute scholarship funding up to the amount of \$7,500 per academic year, per recipient, for up to 5 recipients, not exceeding total amount of cost of tuition & student fees (registration and other required fees for enrollment). Upon approval of selected recipients, The CollegeBoard will issue a check to the UH Foundation in the total award amount, based on the final number of approved applications.

Selection Process:

Recipients shall be nominated and/or selected by a committee of faculty members chosen by the Center for Chinese Studies (SHAPS) and the Department of East Asian Languages & Linguistics (CLLL). Selected teacher candidate applications will be reviewed and approved by China's Office of Chinese Language Council International (Hanban) and The CollegeBoard, or designated representatives.
