Upon notification of acceptance to the camp, each student must send the following materials by **April 25, 2008**. Failure to do so may result in cancellation of the original acceptance.

- \_\_\_ 1. A digital high resolution head-shot in jpg format (most recent preferred).
- \_\_\_ 2. A paragraph introducing yourself to other camp participants.

**Submit by MAIL:**

- \_\_\_ 1. Your round-trip travel itinerary, if applicable. Airport pick-up and drop-off will be arranged based on your itinerary. If you have special request for pick-up and drop-off of your child/children (meeting at the arrival gate, etc.), please notify us in writing in advance.  
(Please arrive on Sunday, July 6, 2008 and depart on Saturday, July 26, 2008. Please also note that the UH on-campus housing check in begins at 2 pm and check out is by 12 pm; we recommend that you find flights to fit these parameters. )
- \_\_\_ 2. A check payable to the **University of Hawaii** in the amount of \$600.  
(Note: Our refund policy is as follows--80% refunded if you withdraw **by May 10, 2008**; 20% refunded if you withdraw **by June 1, 2008**; thereafter, there will be no refund. A written notification of Voluntary Withdraw must be provided to the Camp Director prior to the refund deadline)
- \_\_\_ 3. A photocopy, front and back, of your health insurance card. This will be used to obtain medical treatment for you, if required.
- \_\_\_ 4. A doctor's prescription for any medications that you are to take while at camp.  
(All medications must be properly labeled and in original containers. They will be inspected by the Student Affairs Manager upon your arrival. You will be expected to self-medicate according to directions, and NOT share your medication with others.)
- \_\_\_ 5. Written instructions from your parent or guardian listing any over-the-counter medications you may NOT be given (aspirin, antihistamines, antiseptics, antibiotic ointments, etc.).  
Medications not on this list might be offered to you if deemed helpful by camp staffers.

Please be reminded again that your place within our camp is not guaranteed until all requested materials are received, so please do not delay.
